Ross Fowler was passionate about football (soccer) and shared his love of the game with his community. He coached at local clubs, Evergreen High School and ran the local recreation department's youth soccer program for many years. Ross was not only a coach, he was also a mentor, role model and friend, that had a profoundly positive impact on his players. Sadly, Ross passed away in December of 2019. After his passing, his wife Ann established a scholarship fund in his honor. These funds will be awarded to graduating senior soccer players from Evergreen High School that demonstrate: • A love and passion for the game

- Great teamwork and team spirit
- Outstanding school spirit
- A commitment to community service
- A desire to spread Ross's enthusiasm for the game

There will be 2 scholarships awarded of \$1250 and \$750; funds will go directly towards the tuition and costs of the recipient's attendance at a college or university their freshman year.

Recipients will be determined by a committee of 3 individuals; none of which have any direct ties or conflicts of interest with the soccer program or its participants.

Please submit the following items:

- An essay no longer than 500 words which highlights your qualifications, your educational plans, and why you feel you are deserving of this scholarship. Tell us why your student athlete high school career thus far qualifies you to be awarded a college scholarship.
- Academic Record Cumulative GPA through May 2022 (Must be above a 3.0) Athletic Record All competitive level soccer teams you've played for and any honors, awards, or captain positions. Please include a copy of your unofficial transcript from infinite campus.
- Volunteer work Anything related to soccer including camps, helped refereeing or coaching, etc.
- Coach or teacher recommendation (Needs to be someone other than Coach Phil) * College / University planning to attend in the fall (if known)

Deadline for submission is October 1, 2022. Please include your name, and contact information on the submission. All entries must be in a word document. Your personal information will be redacted before being forwarded to the committee, so that it is a blind selection process.
